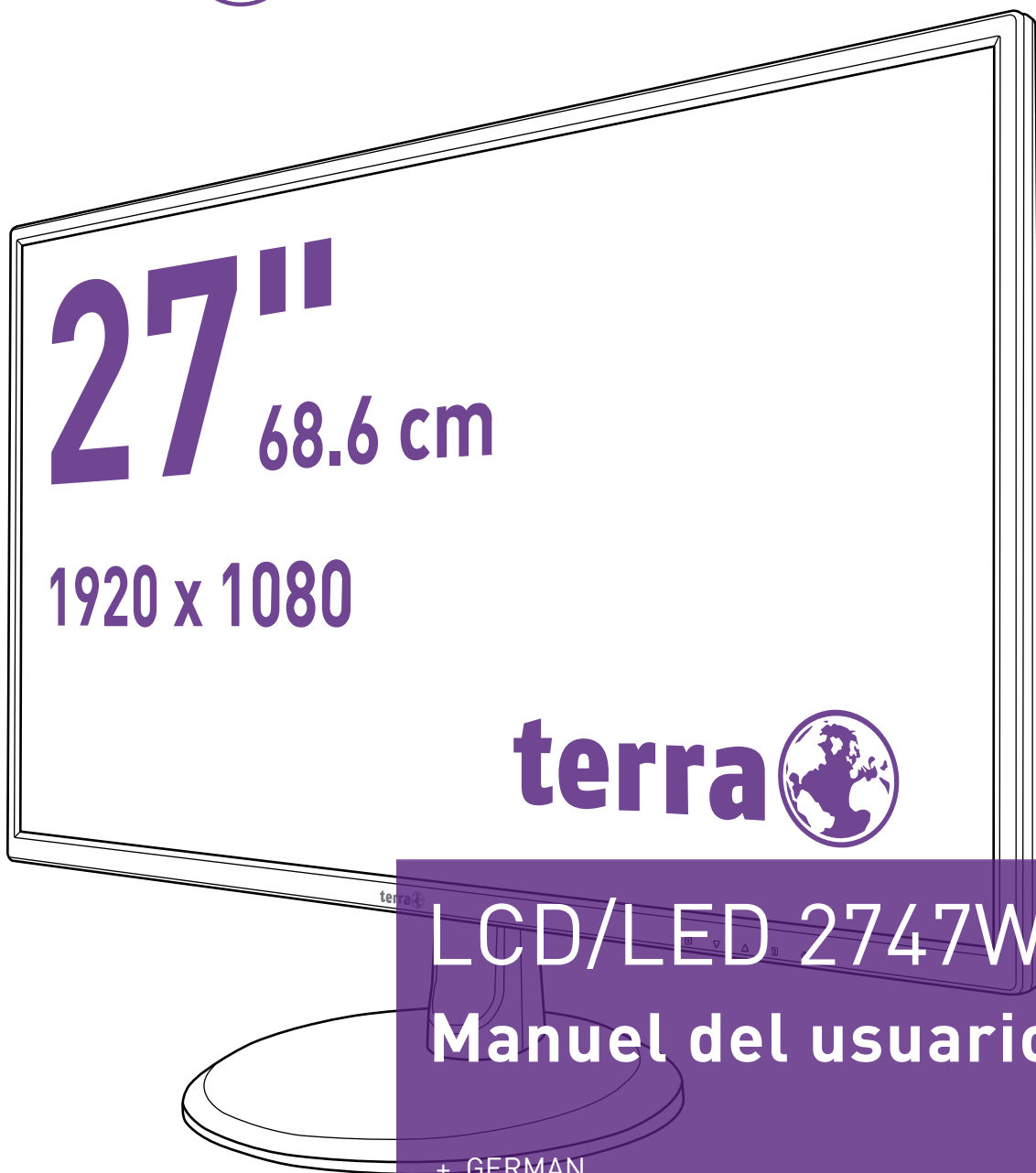

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Precauciones de seguridad y mantenimiento

Lea este manual atentamente y consérvelo por si tiene que consultarlo en otro momento.

1. Desenchufe el monitor antes de limpiarlo con un paño ligeramente húmedo.
2. Es recomendable limpiar la pantalla con un paño seco y solamente cuando la alimentación está desconectada.
3. No utilice alcohol o líquidos que contengan amoníaco.
4. Este monitor está diseñado con orificios de ventilación en la parte posterior de la carcasa. No los tape ni los bloquee.
5. Also avoid placing the monitor near the electric heater or heater. Including in an enclosed room with no ventilations.
6. No inserte ningún material ni rocíe líquido en él.
7. No coloque el monitor sobre en espacio inseguro ya que, si se cae, puede dañarse y provocar lesiones al usuario.
8. Desenchufe el monitor si no lo va a utilizar durante un período prolongado de tiempo.
9. No coloque elementos pesados sobre el monitor o el cable eléctrico.
10. Debido a la existencia de corriente de alto voltaje, no abra el panel posterior.

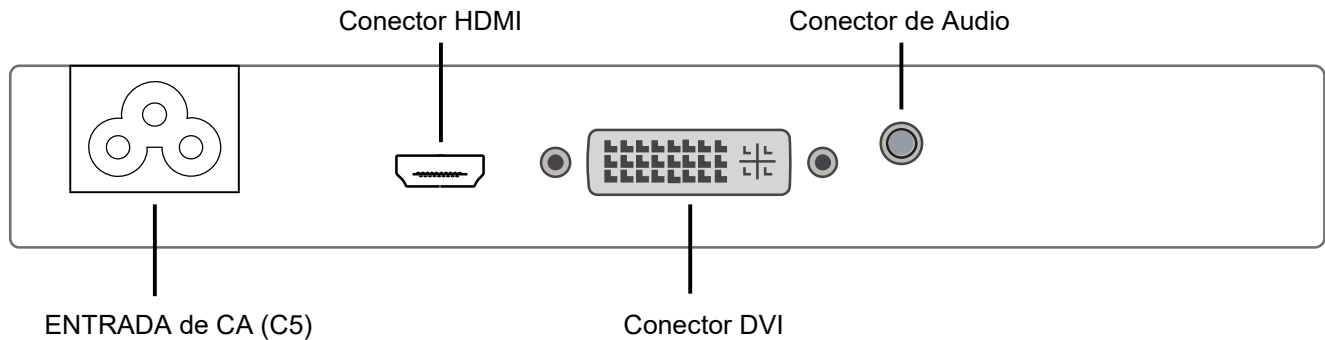

Configuración básica

a) Conecte un cable DVI o cable HDMI a su PC (salida de señal) y al monitor.



- b) El monitor tiene un intervalo de voltaje de potencia amplio: se puede utilizar en una toma de corriente de 100-240 VCA y 60/50 Hz.
- c) Conecte el cable de alimentación a la toma de corriente de alimentación del monitor y a toma de corriente de la sala.
- d) Encienda la fuente de alimentación.
- e) Para encender el monitor, presione el botón de control de alimentación.



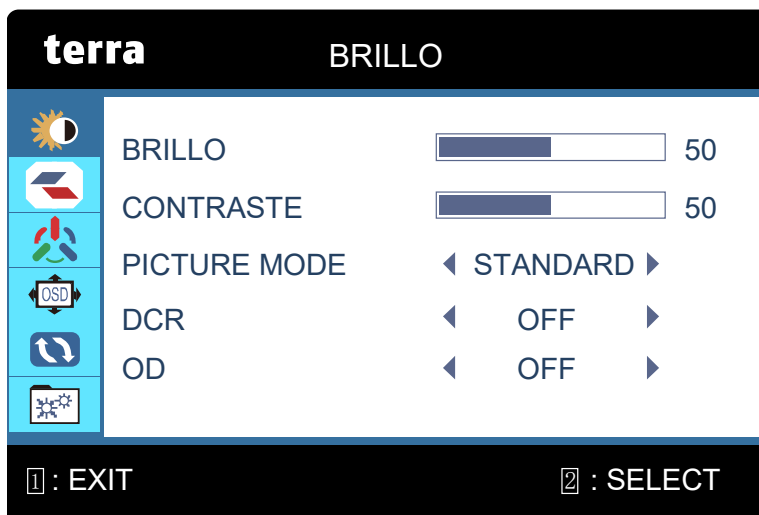

DCR (Relación de contraste dinámico)

Presione el botón  /  para seleccionar **DCR**, y a continuación, presione el botón  para confirmar la selección y presione el botón  /  para seleccionar ON o OFF.

OD (Overdrive)

Presione el botón  /  para seleccionar **OD**, y a continuación, presione el botón  para confirmar la selección y presione el botón  /  para seleccionar FUERTE, MIDDLE, DÉBIL, OFF.

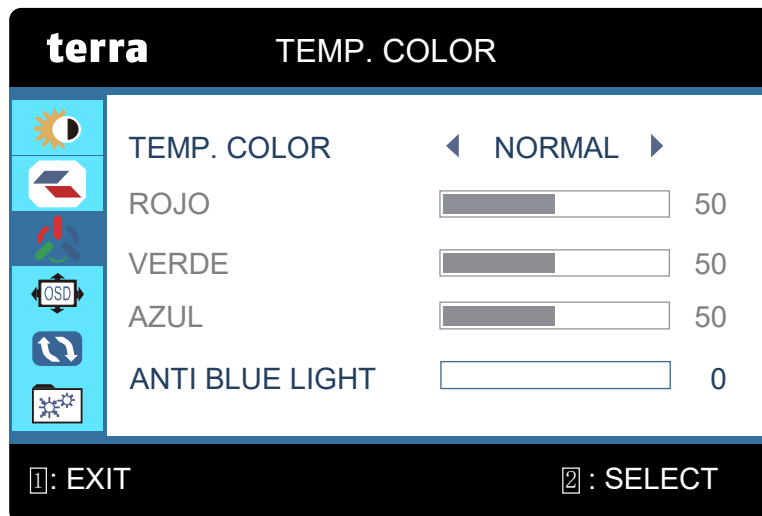


ASPECTO

ROJO

Cuando elija **TEMP. COLOR USUARIO**, presione el botón \triangle / ∇ para seleccionar **ROJO**, y a continuación, presione el botón \square para ajustar el valor de los tres colores primarios de rojo.

VERDE

Cuando elija **TEMP. COLOR USUARIO**, presione el botón \triangle / ∇ para seleccionar **VERDE**, y a continuación, presione el botón \square para ajustar el valor de los tres colores primarios de verde.

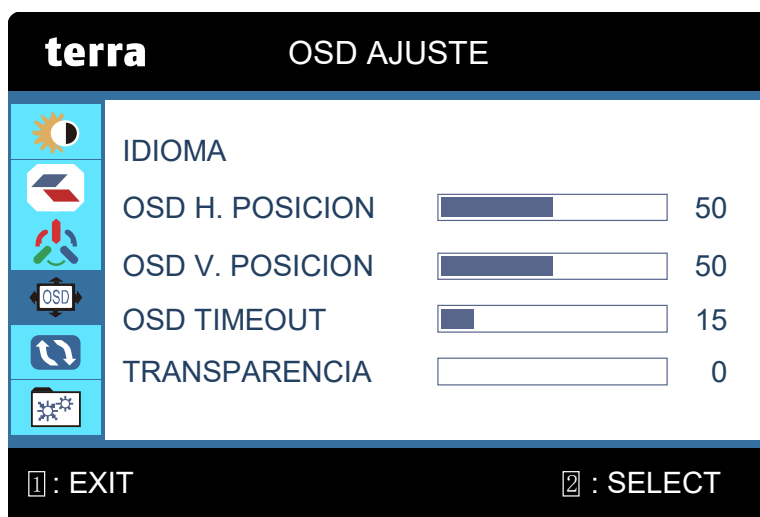
AZUL

Instalar el monitor LED

Solución de problemas

1. Sin imagen en pantalla

- a) Compruebe que el botón de encendido esté activado.
- b) Compruebe que el brillo y contraste del monitor sean normales.
- c) Compruebe que el indicador de alimentación esté parpadeando. Si es el caso, indica que el monitor no recibe la señal de entrada.
- d) Si el indicador de señal es de un portátil, asegúrese de que la señal se haya cambiado a modo pantalla.

2. Imagen desenfocada

- a) Compruebe que el cable de señal de imagen esté correctamente introducido (posición derecha).

3. Parpadeo de pantalla

- a) La potencia es insuficiente para conectar el monitor o es demasiado débil.
- b) Para evitar que haya campos magnéticos alrededor del monitor, no coloque los siguientes dispositivos cerca de éste: Altavoces, luces fluorescentes, transformadores CA, ventiladores de sobremesa, etc.

4. Color incorrecto o poco habitual

- a) si desaparece el rojo, verde, azul o cualquier color, compruebe que el cable de señal esté correctamente conectado. Si la toma está suelta puede provocar una mala conexión.
- b) Pruebe a conectar con otro PC para comparar.

5. Limpieza del monitor

- a) Asegúrese de que el monitor se haya apagado.
- b) No rocíe ningún líquido en la pantalla ni el panel de plástico directamente.

6. Limpieza de la pantalla

- a) Use un material limpio, suave y sin pelos para limpiar la pantalla.
- b) Si sigue sucia, añada un poco de limpia cristales sin amoníaco ni alcohol para limpiar la pantalla.

7. Limpieza del panel de plástico

- a) Use una gamuza suave seca.
- b) Añada un poco de limpiador sin amoníaco, alcohol ni abrasivo para limpiar la superficie si sigue sucia.
